



Steps to Apply for Rhema Student Housing

Rhema students are responsible for securing their own housing and employment. The **rbtc.org** website provides resources to assist you in your search. A downloadable RBTC Job & Housing Guide is available at **rbtc.org/spiritual-life/before-you-move**. Information in the guide includes apartment/house locating websites, several nearby apartment complexes, and a list of companies that have hired Rhema students.

Accepted students have access to the Rhema Job and Housing Wall, which is located across from the Admissions Office in Student Development Center 1 (SDC 1). The wall listings include rooms and houses to rent, the contact information of individuals wanting a roommate, and job openings.

To receive the listings by email or to add your name to the roommate list, please contact Christy Wicks, Recruitment Administrator, at **cwicks@rhema.org**.

Located across the street from Rhema USA is the 96-unit Greg Smith Memorial Student Housing. These one- and two-bedroom apartments are unfurnished and are reserved for *accepted Rhema students*. Due to limited availability, all students are not guaranteed housing.

If you are interested in living at Rhema Student Housing, please follow these steps to apply.

1. Submit an RBTC application and receive an email stating your acceptance.
2. Forward the acceptance email to Christian Damron, Director of Housing, at **cdamron@rhema.org**.
3. Look for a Rhema Student Housing application in your email.
4. Email the completed application to the Director of Housing.
5. Pay the \$20 Rhema Student Housing application fee by calling the RBTC Admissions Office at 918-258-1588, ext. 2260.

Please note: Once the above steps are completed, *you are placed on a waiting list*. Apartments become available the first week of June for fall enrollment and the first week of December for spring enrollment. You will not be contacted before that time.

If housing is needed before June or January, please review the RBTC Job & Housing Guide.

Rhema Student Housing Price Range (subject to change):

- 1 bedroom/1 bath—\$525
- 2 bedroom/1 bath—\$600
- 2 bedroom/2 bath—\$615

After an application is approved and a housing unit assigned, a security deposit of one month's rent is required to hold the apartment.
