

10 Steps to Apply for Rhema Student Housing

Located across the street from Rhema USA is the 96-unit Greg Smith Memorial Student Housing. These one- and two-bedroom apartments are unfurnished and are reserved for *accepted Rhema students*. Due to limited availability, all students are not guaranteed housing. If you are interested in living at Rhema Student Housing, please follow these steps to apply.

- 1. Complete and submit a Rhema Bible Training College application.
- 2. Receive a letter stating your acceptance.
- 3. On a copy of your acceptance letter include:
 - a. Current mailing address and phone number
 - b. Current email address
 - c. Marital status
 - d. Name and age of spouse
 - e. Name(s) and ages(s) of children

- f. Your age
- g. Indicate if you are male/female
- h. Year of school (1st, 2nd, or 3rd)
- i. Unit size preferred (1 or 2 bedroom)
- j. Your approximate arrival date
- 4. Mail or email a copy of your acceptance letter with the above information to:

- **5.** Once your acceptance letter is received, you will receive a letter and a Rhema Student Housing rental application. This indicates that your name has been placed on the waiting list.
- **6.** Complete and return the rental application with the \$20 non-refundable application fee to the Rhema Student Housing office.
- 7. Available units will be assigned by the last week of May/first week of June upon the Dean's approval.
- 8. You will be contacted whether you are assigned a unit or not.
- 9. Once a housing unit is assigned, a security deposit of one month's rent is required to hold the unit. Rhema Student Housing prices are: 1 bedroom—\$575; 2 bedroom—\$650; 2 bedroom/2 bath—\$665. Prices are subject to change.
- **10.** Roommates—When a student resident decides to share his/her housing unit with a roommate, the intended roommate must: submit a copy of his/her letter of acceptance, complete a rental application, pay the \$20 application fee, and be approved by the Dean prior to moving into the unit.

If you have not been assigned a unit, a Student Housing roommate waiting list is available for your perusal at the Student Housing office. If you wish, you can be placed on the roommate waiting list upon submitting your RBTC acceptance letter.
